Self-perception as a reader

- **1st graders** reported that reading was easier for them after completing two programs.
- **2nd graders** thought reading to be easier after their first program and this continued in following programs.
- There were mixed results for **3rd graders** in ease of reading.

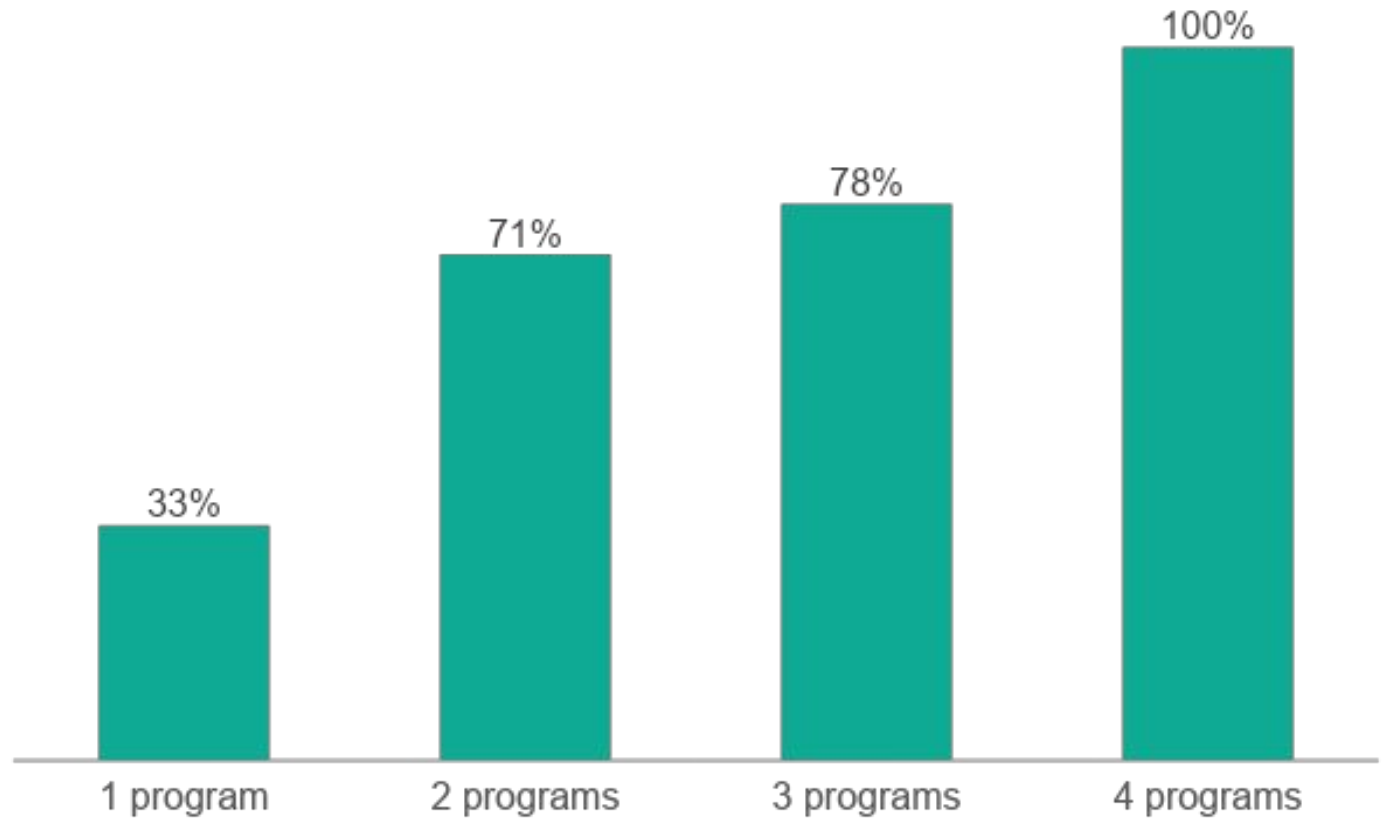
